In April 2012, Pamela received licensure with the Arizona Board of Behavioral Health Examiners (AZBBHE) as a Licensed Associate Counselor (LAC).

Pamela began her career doing lay counseling at a church-based inner city pregnancy care center in Pennsylvania in 1995. She has also been involved in mentoring women through her local church and facilitating Celebrate Recovery support groups. In 2005 she began working at a postsecondary university advising students on their educational and career pursuits.

Pamela completed an internship at Scottsdale Bible Church’s Counseling Center in 2009 and an internship at Calvary Addiction Recovery Center in 2010, working in the inpatient residential program with drug, alcohol and gambling addictions, as well as a variety of other co-occurring mental health disorders. Pam joined the staff at NWCC as a therapist in May of 2012.
